AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED any employee obtaining Utility Department Certification shall receive twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per hour, or salary equivalent, per level of certification up to a maximum of 4 certifications.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED any hourly Police Department employee obtaining certification in department deemed critical courses shall receive twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per hour, per level of certification up to a maximum of 4 certifications.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED all salaries and wages, plus overtime and longevity, will be paid according to the Lead Employee's Handbook.
