ORDINANCE #1108-24

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING LEAD CITY ORDINANCES TITLE IX, CHAPTER 94, STREETS; PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS, BY AMENDING SECTION 94.034

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Lead that, pursuant to SDCL 9-19, section of Lead Ordinance Title IX, Chapter 94, Streets; Public Improvements, Section 94.034 be amended to read as follows:

§ 94.034 SNOW INTO STREETS.

- (A) Any individual or business who deliberately or intentionally removes snow or ice and places it into a public street, road or travel way shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to § 94.999.
- (B) Placement of snow onto a street department-created pile or windrow will be allowed.
- (C) Placement of hand-shoveled snow or ice, by residential homeowners or tenants, onto public streets, roads or travel ways prior to the removal of the snow by street crews shall be allowed. This placement of snow must be of a reasonable nature and must not create an additional burden to city crews.
- (D) Individuals or businesses will not be allowed to plow snow onto public streets, roads or travel ways under any circumstances.

§ 94.034 SNOW INTO STREETS.

- (A) Placement of hand-shoveled snow or ice, by residential homeowners or tenants, onto public streets, roads or travel ways shall be allowed. This placement of snow must be of a reasonable nature and must not create an additional burden to city crew or create a traffic hazard to the public.
- (B) Placement of snow onto a street department created pile or windrow will be allowed by private persons. Commercial placement or dumping of snow from private property onto street department created piles or windrows shall not be allowable. The placement of the snow must not impede the flow of vehicle traffic, pedestrian traffic, or the clear view of traffic signs.
- (C) Any individual or business who deliberately or intentionally removes snow or ice and places it into a public street, road or travel way to a degree which is unreasonable in nature and creates an additional burden to city crew, or creates a traffic hazard to the public shall be quilty of a class II misdemeanor and subject to § 94.999.
