CHAPTER 32: OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

SECTION 32.02 APPOINTIVE OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Lead that, pursuant to SDCL 9-19, section of Lead Ordinance Title III, Chapter 32, Officers and Employees, Section 32.02 Appointive Officers be amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 32: OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

§ 32.02 APPOINTIVE OFFICERS.

The City Administrator, Public Works Directors, Public Safety Administrator/Chief of Police Building Official, City Finance Officer, and City Librarian shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the Commission and shall hold office during good behavior or until their successors are duly appointed and qualified. The City Attorney, City Engineer, and such other officers as may be necessary for the administration of city business and affairs shall be appointed by the mayor with approval of the Commission at the first meeting in May for a term of one year or until their successors are duly appointed and qualified.

The appointive officers of the city shall be a City Administrator, Public Works Administrator, Public Safety Administrator/Chief of Police, Building Official, City Finance Officer, City Librarian, City Attorney, City Engineer, City Newspaper, City Depositories and other officers as may be necessary for the administration of city business and affairs. All the appointments shall be made as provided for by state law and this code of ordinances and unless otherwise provided for by ordinance shall be made at the first meeting in May of each year and shall be for a term of one year, or until their successors are duly appointed and qualified.
